Louisa Gators Swim Team Volunteer Opportunities

During Swim Meets:

Clerk of Course - must arrive 1.5 hours prior to start of home meets to set up benches and Clerk of Course area. The clerks work directly with swimmers and organize them in the right order for each swim meet. Need a minimum of four for each meet – Clerks usually work the entire meet.

Gator Wranglers – will be responsible for gathering swimmers and getting them to the Clerk of Course area at the appropriate time. Will need a minimum of 2 each meet – Wranglers usually work the entire meet.

Stroke & Turn Judge – acts as the judge during a swim meet, watching for correct technique and appropriately timed starts. Must be willing to disqualify swimmers when necessary. ***Mandatory training is required and provided by Jefferson Swim League ~ dates will be posted on jsl.org.*** This is a good job if you want to learn the proper technique and to be able to watch up close. A minimum of 6 needed per meet (3 each half).

Sweep Judge – will sit at side of pool and visually determine the order of finishing in each heat and record result on paper. Need 4 per meet (2 each half). Shoes and clothing, which can be wet, are a necessity!

Timers – will stand at the pool end with a stopwatch (provided) and time each swimmer within the lane – recording results at the end of each heat. 18 – 24 timers are needed each meet (usually only work half the meet). Comfortable shoes and clothing, which can get wet, are a necessity!

Runners – at the end of each heat, runners will travel from the timers in each lane to the scoring table. Wear comfortable shoes and clothing, runners stay on the go the entire time. Need 4 per meet (2 each half).

Refreshments – responsible for fixing and serving drinks to meet workers throughout the meet. Need a minimum of 4 per meet (2 each half).

Sorter (at the Score Table) – Circles the appropriate time for the computer operation and places cards in lane and heat order

Computer Operator (at the Score Table) – enters finish times for swimmers into the computer, mandatory training is required and provided by the Jefferson Swim League – dates will be posted on website at jsl.org.

Computer Assistant (at the Score Table) – works with Computer Operator, reading the finish times from cards in order to facilitate computer entry

Checker (at the Score Table) – will compare computer entries to cards to check for accuracy

Ribbons (at the Score Table) – will place stickers on back of ribbons for heat

Additional Volunteer Duties Available

Ribbon Organizer – will put each swimmer's ribbons into envelopes and place envelopes in alphabetical order for distribution at picnics

Picnic Coordinator – will work with parents to insure that swim team picnics are properly planned and supplies are available

Publicity – can be an adult or older teen with solid writing skills. Will be responsible for submitting articles on time to local weekly papers (The Central Virginian & The Orange Review). Duties may be handled by more than one person.

Team Photographer – will be responsible for taking candid pictures of team throughout the season. Should be available to attend most practices to ensure that all swimmers are photographed. Pictures may be taken by more than one photographer; however, the Team Photographer shall ensure that ALL team members are included in pictures.
