

## Basic Materials for Beginning Sewing Lessons

### Pattern # McCalls 5504 Unisex PJ's

Sewing machine/instruction book and attachments and extra bobbins

If you need a machine, I would suggest going to Sears Or Singer there is nothing wrong with buying a used machine, from a good dealer, Just make sure you can return it if you don't like how it sews!!!!!! and if your machine is new to you please take the "Know Your Machine Class" our class time is valuable, there will be home work.

scissors : paper- these can be small or med size

sharp fabric 8-9" long buy good ones they can be resharpend

Cost \$20-30

Small embroidery or snips -for cutting threads and picking out

Thread and seams

Seam ripper- can be optional if you have good thread snips

Seam gauge -small ruler 6" ruler must have 1/8",/1/4",1/2" and so on  
clearly marked

Cloth tape measure

straight pins: fine dressmaker , they can have colored tops

Pin cushion: magnetic or old fashion tomato

Hand needles Asst Sharps': No self threading or large eyed

Fabric marker: washable pink or blue pin or traditional tracing wheel

Note book. pencil or pin

Good attitude and patients

Optional items that are good to have:

Cutting Board (made of card board with 1" grid pattern Fabric Hut has them)

Yard stick - wood or metal

Transparent tape

Sewing Machine oil/ screw driver/machine needles

Iron and ironing board ( do not bring to class)

small 1st aid kit ( at least a band aid, blood on fabric is not good)
